Your student will be automatically registered for Theater Practicum (course #5231), a 5<sup>th</sup> hr. class awarding credit for each show they participate in. ## Academic Eligibility:

Performing arts students must meet academic eligibility requirements at FCHS. If a student has a failing grade in any class, they must raise the grade to passing before they can continue to attend rehearsals or tech work. Eligibility will be pulled on a weekly basis throughout the production.
