



Fort Collins High School Performing Arts Department 2026 - New York City Cultural Experience Tour Proposal #2NYC / March 18 – 21, 2026

TOUR PACKAGE INCLUSIONS:

- Private bus transfer from Fort Collins HS to Denver International Airport
- R/T airline flights from DIA to the NYC or Newark Airport
- R/T transfers from NYC/NJ Airport to a Midtown Manhattan hotel
- 3 nights in a Midtown Manhattan hotel
- 4 Broadway Shows (TBA)
- Broadway Theatre Workshop - Potential classes offered are "Broadway Rehearsal", "Theatre Games/Improv", "Stage Combat", "Business of the Business", "The Audition", and "Q & A" with a Broadway guest teacher
- Backstage tour of Radio City Music Hall or Broadway Theatre
- Lunch at Ellen's Famous Stardust Diner
- \$25 per day meal allowance (\$100 total per person)
- Time and weather permitting visits to Central Park, Rockefeller Center, 5th Avenue, Madison Avenue, The High Line, Chelsea Market, Grand Central Station, etc.

- One luggage tag per traveler
- Tour Manager accompanies group

Estimated Tour Package Prices*:

Quad Occupancy (4 to a room) - \$1,950 per person

*Prices are based on 2025 pricing with **40** paying participants in quad rooms and **4** chaperones/directors in single/double rooms. Any reduction in room occupants will incur an additional fee. Pricing does not include items of a personal nature, meals or activities during free time.

**Final pricing will be determined based on confirmed travel numbers, airline flights contracted, hotel room configurations (per the final rooming list), Broadway shows and activities selected.*

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENTS FOR THE TOUR: All participants should register online at americaninternationaltravel.net. Click on Registration/Insurance Forms and find your school. Once submitted, a tour and/or insurance invoice will be emailed within 72 hours. There is a link in the invoices that allows you to pay online by credit card (Visa/MC/Discover/American Express), ACH, or E-check. All payments should be made to American International Travel and Tours. and payment receipts with reminders of the balance/next payment will be sent by email to the participant. Physical checks can be mailed to our offices in Greenwood Village.

CANCELLATION PENALTIES:**

August 1, 2025 – August 31, 2025	- \$ 500 is nonrefundable
September 1, 2025 – September 30, 2025	- \$ 800 is nonrefundable
October 1, 2025 – October 31, 2025	- \$1,000 is nonrefundable
November 1, 2025 – January 14, 2026	- \$1,500 is nonrefundable
January 15, 2026, through tour departure	- The total tour package price is nonrefundable.

****OPTIONAL TRAVEL INSURANCE:** Optional Travel Insurance is offered by American International Travel and Tours. This insurance includes protection for cancellation prior to, and during the tour, and potential full monetary loss. Payment can be made by check or online with a credit card through the AI website. **Click on Registration/Insurance Forms to complete the application and receive an invoice to pay through the payment link. PLEASE NOTE THAT THE INSURANCE MUST BE PURCHASED WITHIN 14 DAYS OF THE DEPOSIT TO INCLUDE THE "CANCEL FOR ANY REASON" WAIVER. IT WILL HAVE A SEPARATE INVOICE THAN THE TOUR. STANDARD INSURANCE CAN BE PURCHASED UNTIL JANUARY 14, 2026, BUT MUST BE PURCHASED PRIOR TO YOUR FINAL PAYMENT BEING MADE OR CANCELLING. IN CASE OF CANCELLATION, THE INSURANCE PREMIUM CANNOT BE CLAIMED.**

****Price - \$124.50 per person Student Deluxe Insurance including "CFAR": — Payment must be made within 14 days of making your deposit.**

****Price - \$83 per person for Student Deluxe Insurance – Can be purchased until January 14, 2026, but is only valid if purchased before/with your final payment.**

INSURANCE POLICY PROVIDED BY TRAVEL INSURED

Trip Cancellation - Up to 100% of non-refundable Insured Trip Cost*

Trip Interruption - 150% of non-refundable insured Trip Cost*

Trip Delay - \$2,500 (delayed 6 or more hours - Limit of \$250.00 per day)
